City of Cape Town is proud to be a leader in SSEG, with over 24 MVA of registered solar PV, contributing to a greener, cleaner city. Register your system now for a safe and equitable electricity grid.

Protect your household from electrical fires and electrical shock.

Minimise risk to electricity staff working on the grid. Severe shocks from illegally connected SSEG could lead to death.

Maintain power quality and load management.

Pay for your use of the grid.

- By law, all small-scale embedded generation (SSEG) systems must be authorised by the City of Cape Town
- Register for authorisation by 28 February 2019 to avoid additional service fees and possible electricity disconnection
